



# Paid leave deadlines approaching

# **DEED** outlines requirements for Minnesota program

Minnesota's new paid family and medical leave program takes effect Jan. 1, 2026, but employers across the state are already facing key deadlines to pre-

The law will give most Minnesota workers up to 12 weeks of paid medical leave and 12 weeks of paid family leave each year with a combined maximum of 20 weeks. It is designed to cover both short-term personal health needs and family caregiving.

The Minnesota Paid Leave Division is reminding businesses that they must notify employees by Dec. 1 about the upcoming program and its payroll deductions, according to information on the state's website. Employers must also post an easily accessible workplace notice in English and in any language spoken by five or more employees

or contractors.

Beginning in 2026, the Minnesota Paid Leave program will be funded by a 0.88% payroll tax, split evenly between employer and employee, meaning each partner pays up to 0.44% of wages. An employer may choose to cover a higher percentage of the deduc-

According to information on the Minnesota Department of Employment and Economic Development website, Minnesota Paid Leave applies to almost all employers and individuals that work in Minnesota with exceptions for employees of tribal nations or the federal government and self-employed individuals who choose to provide their own coverage for themselves.

'Paid Leave will help us build on Minnesota's standing as

one of the best states for children and families," said Matt Varilek, DEED commissioner, in an Oct. 22 update on the state website. "Employers play a critical role in ensuring the smooth launch of the new program so that Minnesotans can take the time they need for the moments that matter most."

When the program starts, employees applying for leave will need a certification form completed by a healthcare or service provider, similar to federal Family and Medical Leave Act paperwork. Those forms are already available online through DEED and the state of Minnesota.

The program covers nearly all Minnesota workers, including part-time employees and most seasonal staff. Employers in hospitality industries may apply for a seasonal designation exempting certain positions, but approval is required.

Self-employed workers and independent contractors are not automatically covered but may opt in.

To help employers and individuals prepare, Minnesota Paid Leave officials are hosting webinars. "Intro to Paid Leave" is noon to 1 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 13, and "Paid Leave for New and Expecting Parents" is noon to 1 p.m. Dec. 4.

Recordings from recent sessions covering topics like payroll taxes, hospitality employment and healthcare provider responsibilities are available on the Minnesota Paid Leave website.

Employers who plan to use an equivalent private plan instead of the state program must submit a substitution request by Nov. 15 for coverage starting the first quarter of 2026.

Municipalities, local government entities, religious organizations, non-profits and agricultural employers are all required to participate in Minnesota Paid Leave, according to DEED.

Homestead applications due

**ST. CLOUD** – Property owners in Stearns County who have purchased or moved into a new home within the past year have until Dec. 31 to file a homestead classification application with the Stearns County Assessor's Office. The property tax homestead classification may affect the amount of taxes a property owner will pay in 2026 and may also affect the taxpayer's eligibility for a property

A homestead application should be submitted to the county assessor if the use of the property owned or occupied by a qualifying relative has changed during the past year. A qualifying relative for both agricultural and residential homestead purposes include a parent, stepparent, child, stepchild, grandparent, grandchild, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, nephew or niece of the owner, by blood or marriage.

Once homestead is granted, annual applications are not necessary unless they are requested by the county assessor. Law requires notification to the county assessor within 30 days of the change in homestead status due to a sale, move or for any reason that would no longer qualify the property for the homestead classification.

Applying for homestead classification can be done online for Stearns County parcels by going to stearns.co/homesteadapp. If the property is located in the city of St. Cloud, go to the city's homestead web page at ci.stcloud.mn.us/619/Homestead-Applications.



#### 100 years ago • Nov. 12, 1925 Aulger Bros. will show at Caughren next week

# Government shutdown impacts SNAP

# County administrator provides update

As the federal government shutdown passes the one-month mark, thousands of Stearns County residents are facing the potential loss of food assistance.

Melissa Huberty, human services administrator for Stearns County, said the biggest local impact so far has been to the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, which provides federal food assistance.

"In Stearns County, we have about 12,500 people on SNAP," Huberty said Oct. 29. "October benefits for SNAP have gone out and will go out; however, November benefits, going forward, will not be issued."

The first missed payments began Nov. 1, Huberty said, and a timeline of when program recipients will receive benefits remains undetermined.

Multiple national media outlets reported Monday that the Trump Administration agreed to fund SNAP benefits at roughly 50% using a U.S. Department of Agriculture

contingency fund. Yet, on Tuesday, those same outlets reported President Donald Trump suggested withholding federal food aid funding until the government shutdown ends.

According to Huberty, 7,000 adults and 5,500 children in Stearns County benefit from SNAP.

"They will not get their food support," Huberty said. "And that has a number of consequences to families who rely on that for their food support, and it does have a particularly outsized impact on the rural areas in any place because there are fewer resources for food."

Huberty said SNAP is more than an emergency safety net; it is an economic driver.

"It's generally thought that if you spend \$1 on SNAP, you get about \$1.50 or even way more than that in return," she said. "So, what happens is grocery stores get impacted very quickly."

The loss of benefits also affects working families who depend on assistance to supplement low wages

"Most people on public assistance are already working," Huberty said. "If they don't receive SNAP, they have to take their other income. ... They have to make decisions, 'Am I going to pay my rent, or am I going to pay food?' And usually, people need to survive, so maybe more money will go towards food, and now, you have landlords not getting paid. ... It starts to have this downstream effect that is quite unpleasant."

The effects, she said, could extend beyond economics.

Food shelves across the state are already feeling the strain.

"We're already seeing that the food shelves are running out of food," Huberty said. "We've been told that by many food shelf providers."

To help bridge the gap, the state announced an emergency one-time fund to support food shelves.

"The governor (Gov. Tim Walz) came out yesterday and announced \$4 million for food shelves in the state and in the tribal nations as well ... to support each of those food shelves," Huberty said. "So, I think the state's trying to mitigate some of this risk at the moment, but we already know that food shelves are running dry."

Locally, Blaine
Kostreba, director of Sauk
Centre Community Connection Food Share, said
there has been added use
of the food shelf in Sauk
Centre, but currently, she
is not anticipating shortages of any kind. However,
she stressed cash and
nonperishable donations
are always welcome.

"All cash donations go directly to the food shelf," Kostreba said. "We are all volunteers; none of us are paid employees."

Children make up a large portion of those affected.

"Thirty-six percent are children on SNAP in Minnesota," Huberty said. "In Stearns County, we have about 44% are children. So, it's a big hit on children."

If the shutdown extends into 2026, Huberty said, additional programs could be affected, including Medicaid, senior services and foster care reimbursements.

"We're required to provide all these services, but we won't have the funding to do it," she said.

Each time public assistance has been reduced in the past, Huberty said, there has been a rise in child protection services reports about nine months later

"When people are not getting their basic needs met, there's a lot more stress on the families," she said. "And pretty soon, you have more reports to child protection."


Huberty reiterated that most people who rely on assistance are working.

"I just think, many people think, 'Oh, good, we're kicking people off assistance. They should just get a job," she said. "And I just want to make it clear that most people on assistance already are employed. They're just underemployed. They can't pay for child care, rent, food, transportation, those kinds of things."

For updates on the

federal government shutdown and benefit status, Huberty said, residents can visit SNAP section on the Minnesota benefits government website.

"Calling the counties will not be effective," she said. "We just go to the website, too."
